- Wear your Donate Life T-shirts.

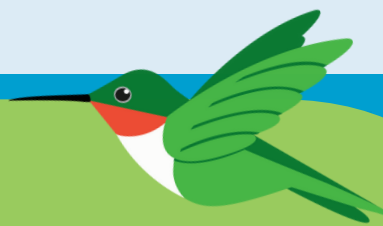


## REGISTRATION GOALS

## COMMUNICATION & SOCIAL MEDIA

- Publish donation and transplantation articles in internal newsletters, intranet or message boards.
- Send email(s) from hospital CEO/other leaders to staff, announcing the campaign, encouraging participation and registration, and including organization's personalized registration link.

- Host a registration table at your office or at a community event.

- Host an event with transplant recipients, donor family members, or transplant professionals to talk about the campaign and the importance of donation registration.
